The MVAH Partners and Omega Community Development Corporation are proud to announce, in conjunction with their partner organizations, the groundbreaking of the Omega Senior Lofts, a brand-new community being built exclusively for adults 55 and over. The ceremony will take place on **Monday, March 4, 2019 at 10:30 a.m.** at 1800 Harvard Boulevard, Dayton, Ohio 45406.

MVAH Partners and Omega Community Development Corporation, along with their partners; the OEF Investment Fund, Ohio Capital Corporation for Housing (OCCH), Federal Home Loan Bank of Cincinnati, and KeyBank National Association; are developing the Omega Senior Lofts as a part of the Federal Affordable Housing Tax Credit Program.

MVAH began developing affordable housing in 1993. Since then they have developed more than 10,000 affordable housing units in 15 states, ranging across a broad spectrum of housing types: multi-story apartment properties for families and seniors, villas, single-family developments, rehabs, adaptive reuse of existing buildings in large and small communities. MVAH has a singular focus on developing quality affordable housing for those who need it most.

The Omega CDC is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization established by the Omega Baptist Church in 1997. Its mission is to equip individuals, families, and children with resources, tools, and opportunities to break the cycle of generational poverty and achieve self-sufficiency through education, workforce development, and advocacy. To accomplish this mission, the Omega CDC has successfully implemented several high quality educational, life skills, and mentoring programs. In 2015, the Omega CDC launched the development of The Hope Center for Families, a 31,400-square foot facility on the 32-acre campus and adjacent to the Omega Senior Lofts. The construction on the Hope Center is expected to begin in fall 2019.
